Mayor "Butch" Coburn opened the Public Hearing of the Common Council of the City of Butler at City Hall, 120 West Main Street at 7:30 pm.

The Mayor read the public hearing notice. He then gave the floor to Ellen Stuckey, the Library Director.


Ellen reported that during the week they did their counts, they had 667 people walk through the doors and answered 64 reference questions. She also reported that they have raised \$1.5 million for the expansion project, many of which were donations. They are still accepting donations for furniture and computer equipment.

Ellen also reported that the advertisement for bids on the construction have gone out. The bids will be opened June 2, at 2 PM at the library.


The library is submitting a budget of \$13,300 for capital projects. This will be used to upgrade computer software and purchase new computers.

Mayor Coburn then asked for questions or comments from the audience. Council Member Olin commented that he feels the library is a real asset for the community. There were no other comments for or against the capital projects budget.

Council Member Olin made a motion to close the public hearing and Council Member Davis seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.
